RULES OF CONDUCT!

PLAYERS:

- 1. Abusive Language and Profanity will not be tolerated.**
- 2. Fighting or taunting opposing players or umpires will not be tolerated. (This includes threats on Social Media).**
- 3. Balls and Strikes are not to be questioned.**
- 4. Any and All attempts to intentionally harm or injure a player will not be allowed.**
- 5. Flipping or Throwing bats will not be tolerated. (It's Umpire's Discretion and can-not be protested). Result could end in Ejection or Warning. (This will be a delayed dead-ball out, result of play will stand, including HR).**
- 6. Altered or Illegal Bats will be not be allowed. (It's player's responsibility to make sure their bats conform to USSSA test).**

EFFECT:

Any Manager/Player guilty of any of the above shall be ejected from the said game and face possible further disciplinary actions.

MANAGERS:

- 1. Are responsible for the conduct of their team.**
- 2. Are responsible for keeping their players in the dug-out.**
- 3. Only Managers are allowed to discuss a situation with an Umpire.**

EFFECT:

Any Manager guilty of any of the above shall be ejected from the said game and face possible further disciplinary actions.
